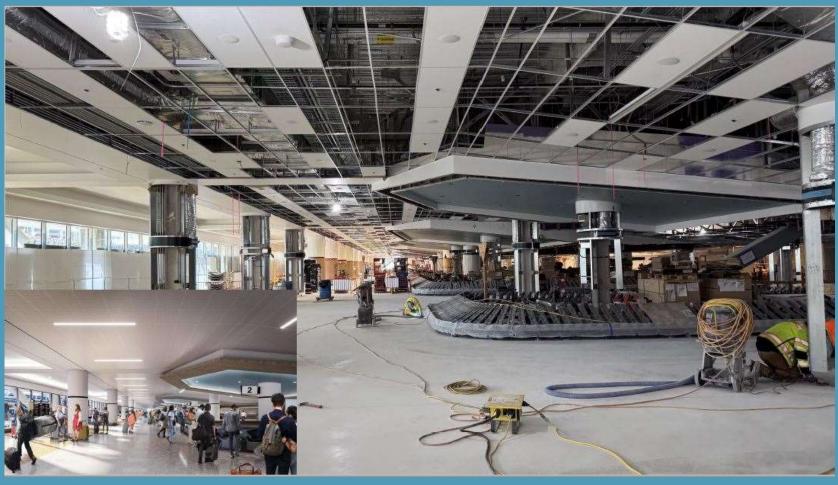

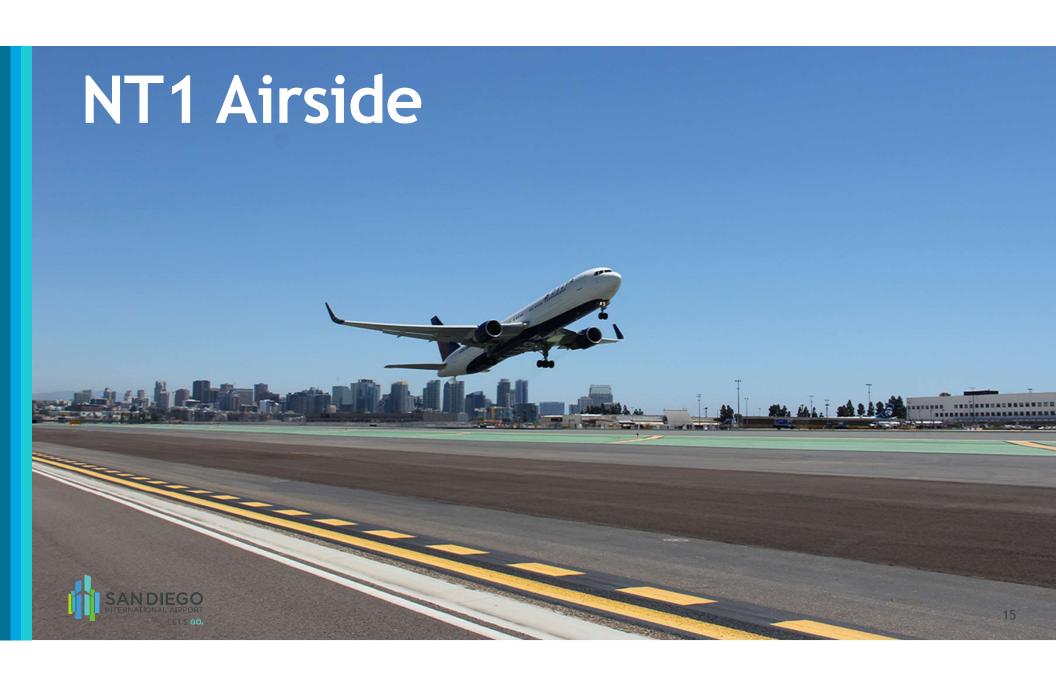

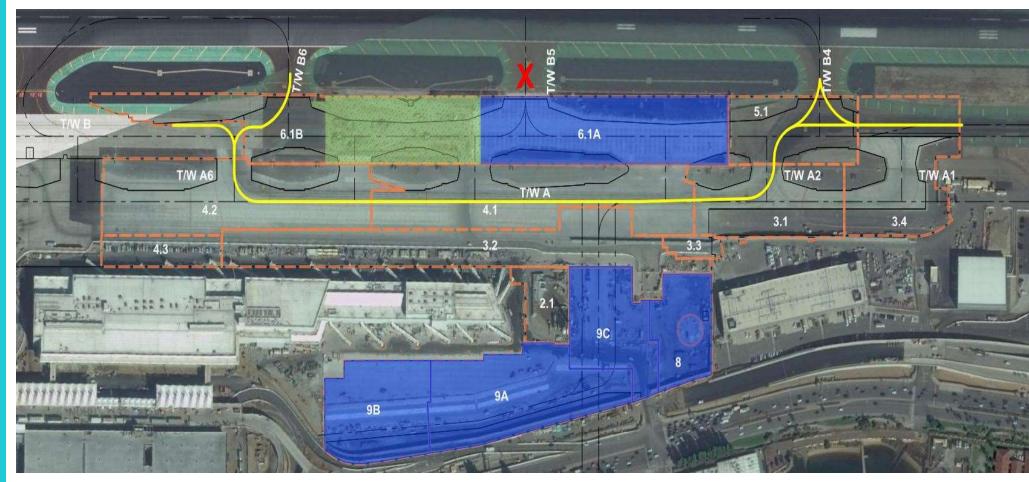

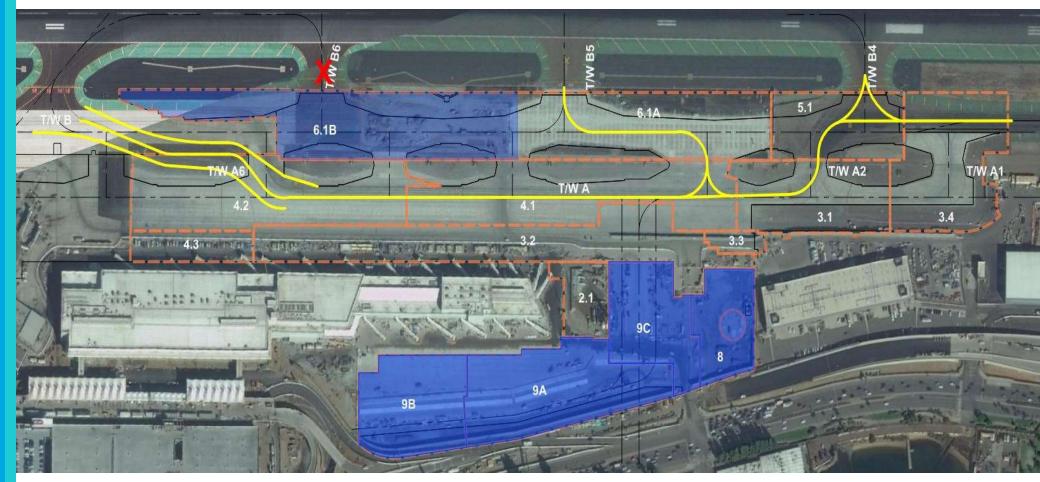


NT1 AIRSIDE IMPROVEMENTS Active Project Phasing Limits - Phase 6.1A Aircraft Routing





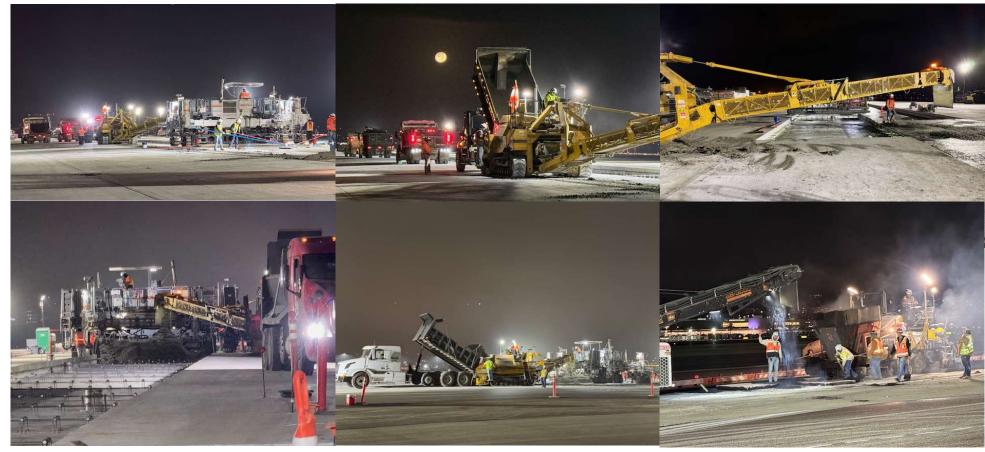

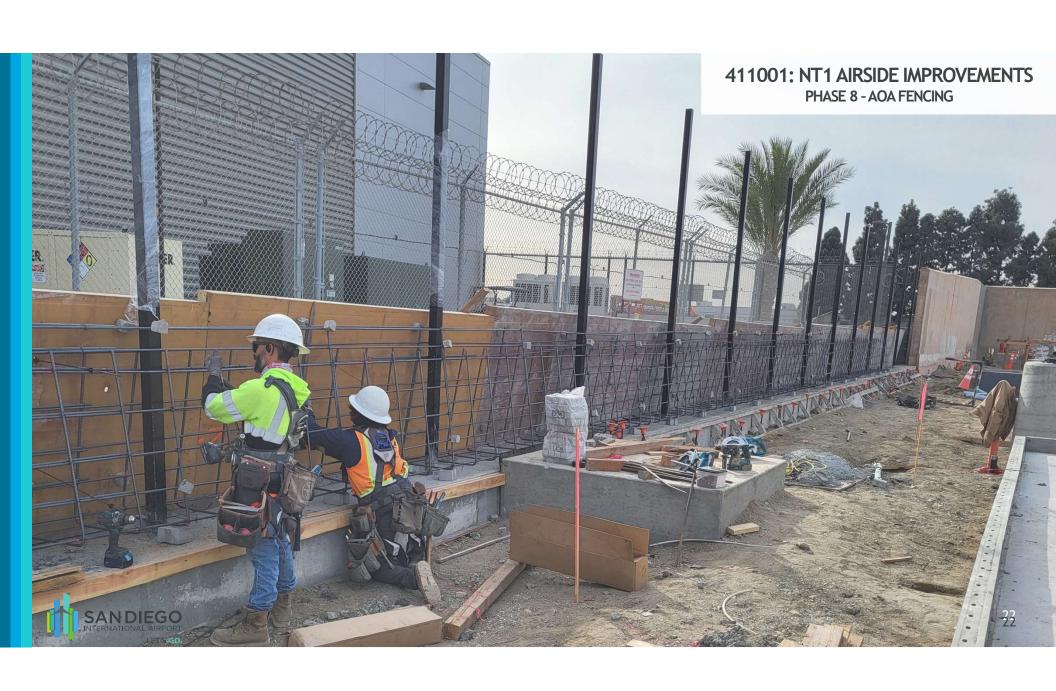

PHASE 6.1A - TWY B CONCRETE PAVING



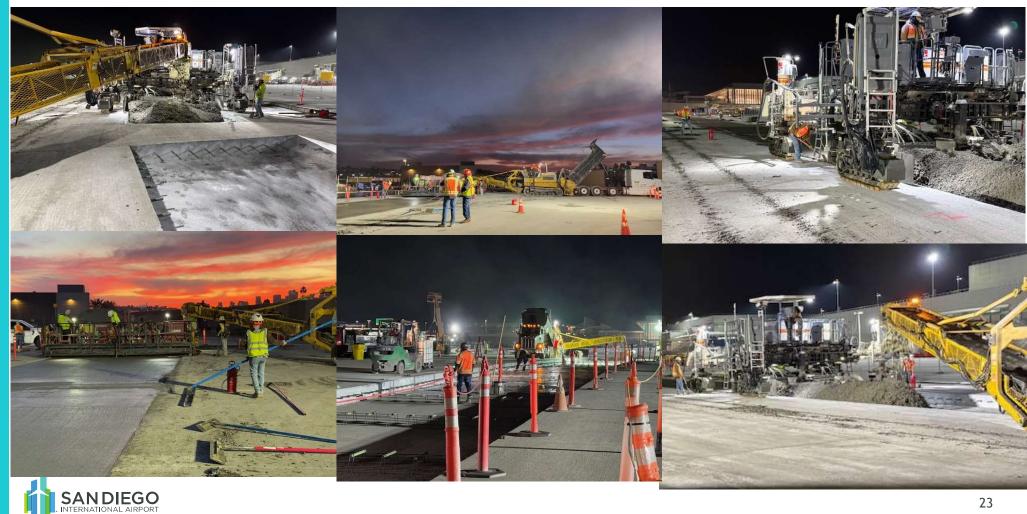


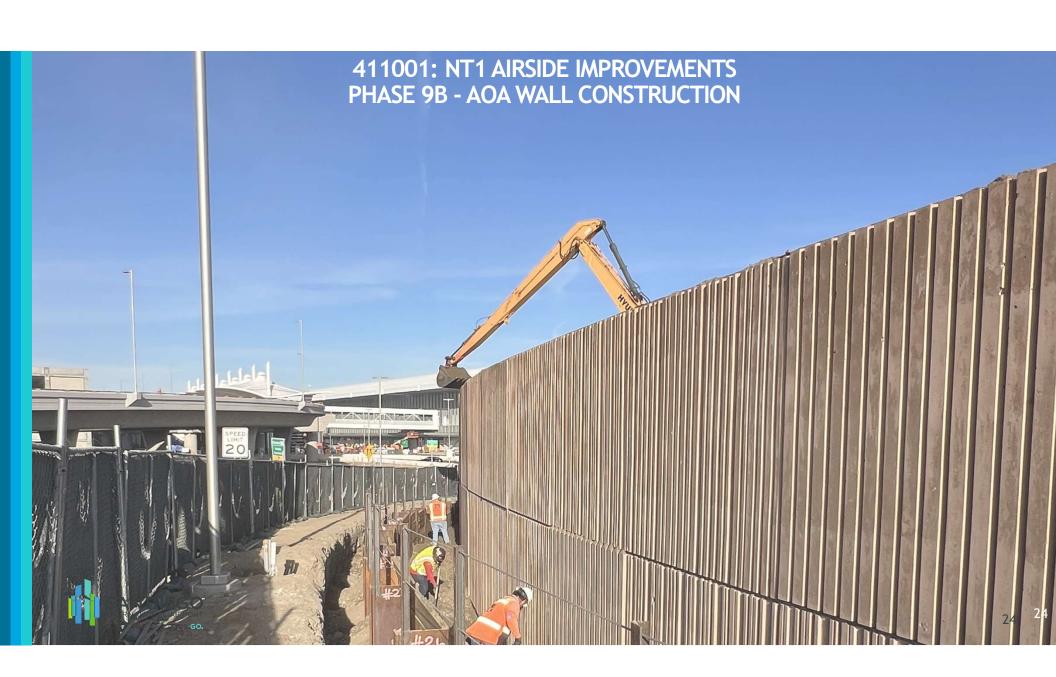

PHASE 9 - CONCRETE PAVING





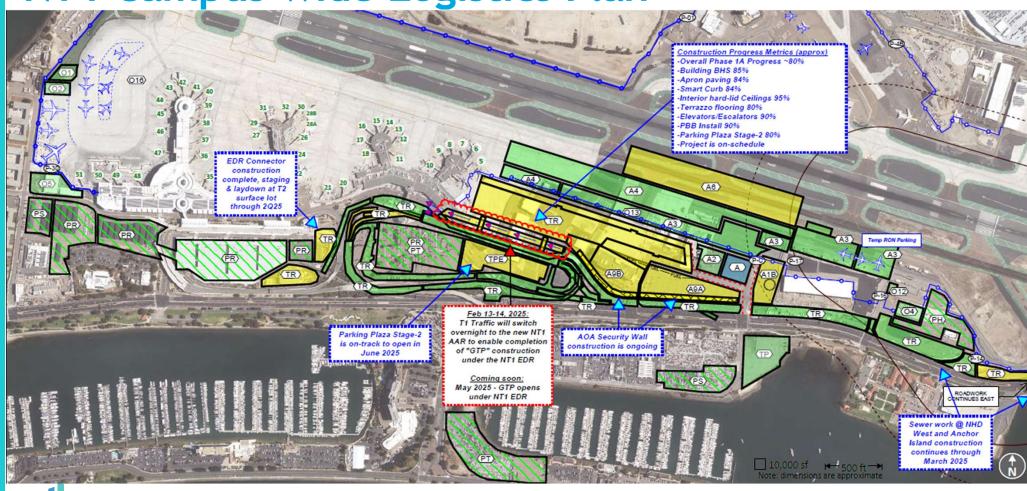

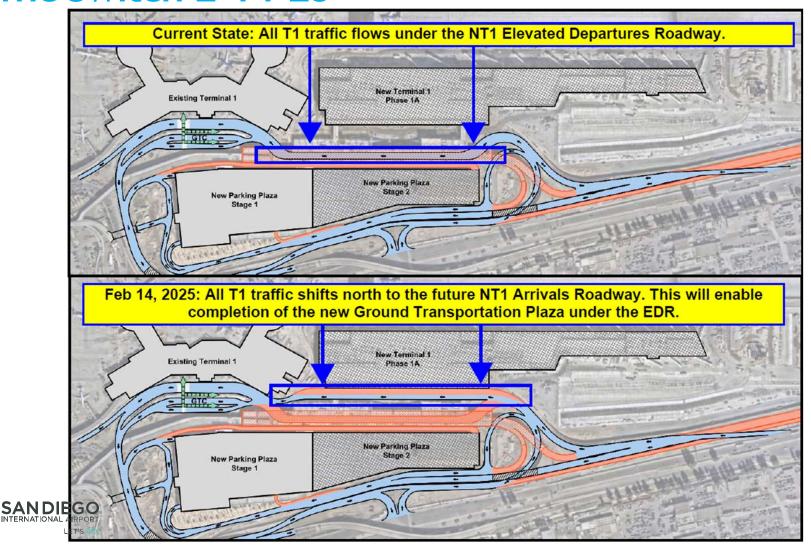


NT1 Campus-wide Logistics Plan

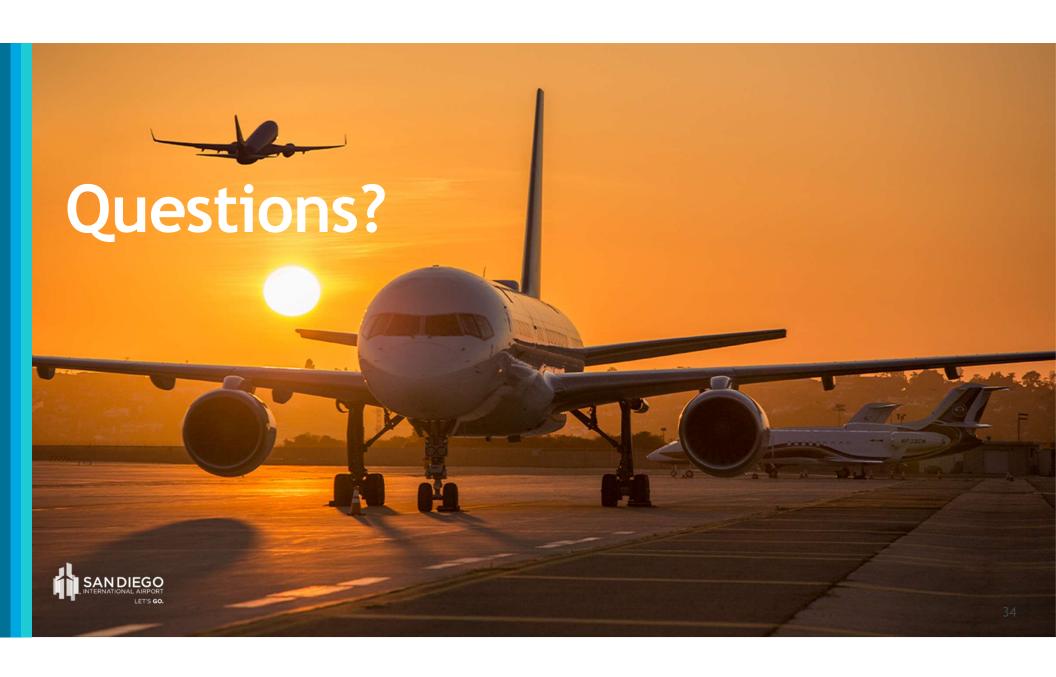

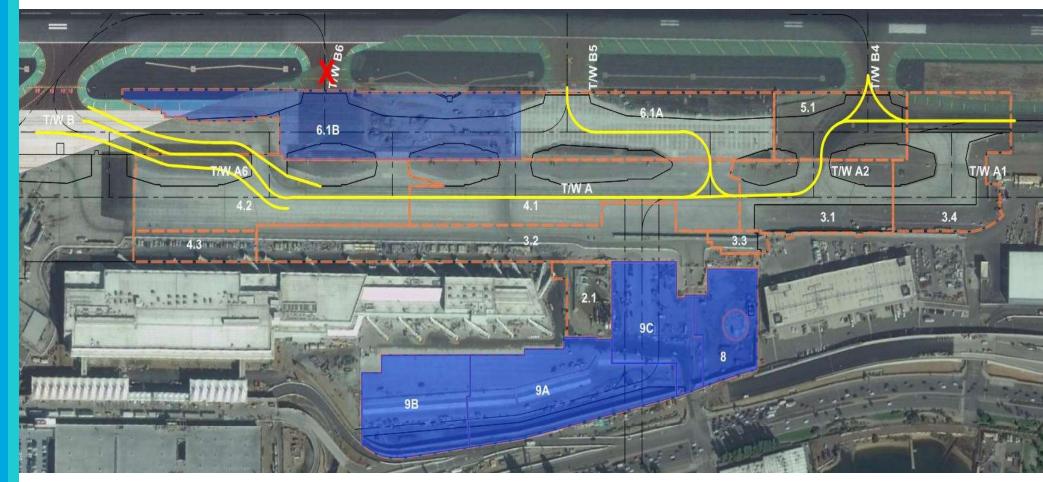

Telecommunications License Agreement

- Awarded to Cellco Partnership DBA Verizon Wireless ("Verizon") to act as the lead Mobile Network Operator (MNO) to finance, plan, design, install, operate and maintain cellular infrastructure (4G and 5G) on behalf of all current and future MNOs operating at the Airport, at their sole cost and expense.
- Verizon has entered into sub-agreements with T-Mobile and AT&T, including cost sharing for infrastructure projects, and will provide fair, nondiscriminatory, and neutral access.
- Term: 15-years with the option for one 5-year extension effective December 1, 2021.
- \$759,000 in annual access fee, paid monthly, with 3% annual escalator.
- Estimated \$25M of cellular infrastructure investment during the first 10 years.
- High performance cellular connectivity is an attribute of a modern airport and is a major key component to enhance the customer experience.

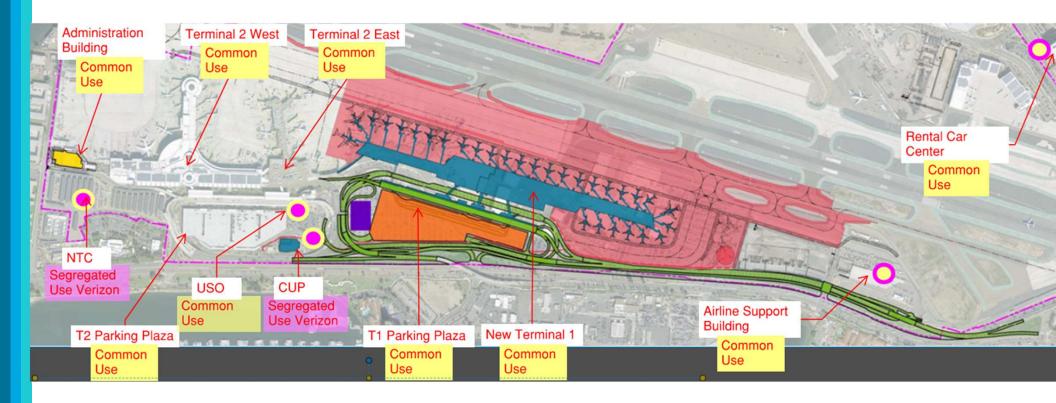

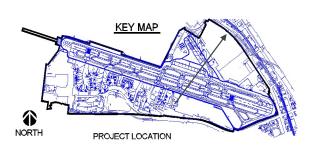

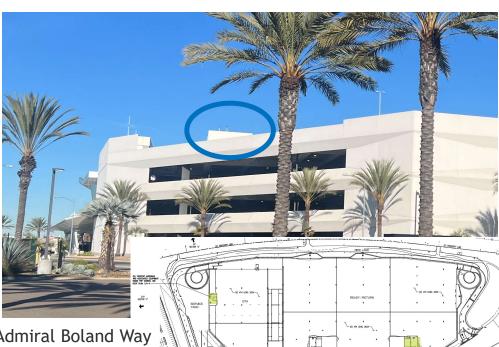

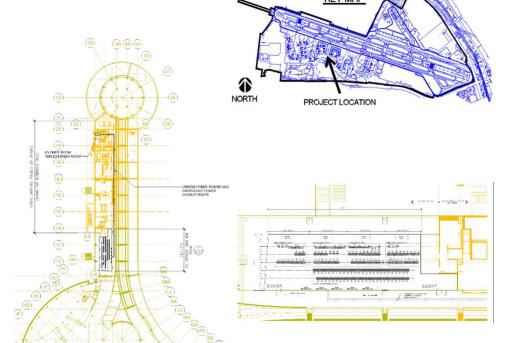

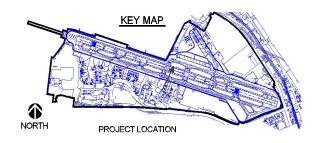

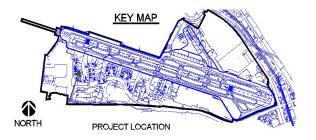
