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CHAPTER 10. CONSULTATION



The San Diego International Airport (SDIA) Title 14, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 150 Noise Compatibility Study Update involved an extensive stakeholder and public involvement process, in accordance with the requirements of the regulation. The San Diego County Regional Airport Authority (SDCRAA), airport sponsor and owner, worked to have an open and inclusive process. The Study was initiated in response to community concerns and recommendations by the Airport Noise Advisory Committee (ANAC). Two committees were formed and met over the course of the Study, in addition to meetings with the ANAC and the public. The type of outreach is summarized below and further information documenting these meetings is included in **Appendix J - Public Coordination**.

10.1 COMMITTEES

Two committees were used to obtain comments from stakeholders throughout the Study. The Community Advisory Committee (CAC) included representatives from communities surrounding the airport, providing a broad view of areas near the airport that can be impacted by aircraft noise. The Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) focused on stakeholders such as air carriers, local jurisdictions, pilots, and the FAA to obtain comments from a technical standpoint. This committee also included two members of the public, who also served on the CAC, to allow for coordination and information dissemination of technical and community issues between the two committees. The two committees met seven times over the course of the Study to review materials and provide comments. The committee meetings were open to the public. Materials from these meetings are included in **Appendix J - Public Coordination**. Additionally, the Study Team met with ANAC at critical points throughout the Study to obtain additional feedback. The list of committee members and affiliations are included in the tables below.

10.2 PUBLIC MEETINGS AND COMMENTS

In addition to the committee meetings, two public workshops were conducted to present information to the public and receive comments. These were conducted in November 2019 and January 2021. Prior to each workshop, advertisements were sent out notifying the public of the meetings. Additionally, all the presentations from the workshops and the committee meetings were provided on the website, and public comments were accepted through the website throughout the Study and are summarized in **Appendix J - Public Coordination**. Comments received were considered and provided feedback and direction throughout the Study process.

A draft was released publicly on March 8, 2021, and comments were accepted through April 21, 2021. A public workshop followed by a public hearing was held on April 8, 2021. Approximately 38 people were in the workshop and hearing. Verbal and written comments were received during this time period, and additional TAC/CAC and ANAC meetings were conducted. The response to comments provided during the public comment period, along with proof of publication of advertisement, the hearing transcript/comments and presentation are included in **Appendix K - Public Hearing/Comment Period**.

10.3 COORDINATION REQUIREMENTS

Per 14 CFR Part 150, a description of public participation and the consultation with officials of public agencies and planning agencies in areas surrounding the airport, FAA regional officials, and other Federal officials having local responsibility for land uses depicted on the map, any air carriers and other users of the airport is required. The Noise Exposure Maps (NEMs) and Noise Compatibility Program (NCP) must be provided to the public for review and comment during the development of the maps. Several opportunities were afforded as noted above, during public and committee meetings. The documentation for this process is included in the narrative above, as well as in Appendix J and K. Based on this documented process, the airport operator certifies that it has afforded interested persons adequate opportunity to submit their views, data, and comments concerning the correctness and adequacy of the draft noise exposure map and descriptions of forecast aircraft operations.
